Ludo Lauwers, M.D. is Senior Vice President, Beerse R&D Site Manager at Johnson & Johnson Pharmaceuticals and chairs the Beerse R&D Senior Leadership Team. He is member of the CNS-IM R&D Board. He is Vice-Chairman of the Management Board of Janssen Pharmaceutica NV and Chairman of the Board of Janssen-Cilag International NV.

He joined Janssen Pharmaceutica, Belgium as Medical Director in 1993, and later served as Director of Clinical Development, Internal Medicine; Senior Director, Internal Medicine, International Clinical R&D and Vice President Gastroenterology & Antifungals for the Janssen Research Foundation (JRF). Ludo was appointed Beerse Site Manager for J&J Pharmaceutical R&D in July 2000 and later in October 2001 Vice President, Global Head, Postmarketing Medical Evaluation. In 2004 he became Global Head of the drug safety and pharmacovigilance organization for J&J, Benefit Risk Management (BRM) and chair of the Safety Council. His previous positions include Medical Director, Upjohn Benelux, and Associate Director of the Department of Anesthesiology and Director of the ICU and Emergency Medical Services at the Stuivenberg General Hospital.

Dr. Lauwers earned his medical degree (MD) from the University of Leuven and specialized in Anaesthesiology and Critical Care Medicine at the University of Antwerp. He holds the European Diploma of Intensive Care Medicine (EDIC).
