

Gilles Rubinstenn



Holding a PhD from the University Pierre and Marie Curie on organic chemistry and statistical quantum mechanics (1996), alumnus of the Ecole Normale Supérieure of Paris (1994), Gilles Rubinstenn began his career in 1998 at L'Oréal. He occupied various positions in the department of Life Sciences mainly dealing with artificial skin engineering and the use of thereof for alternative methods to animal testing. In 2004, he joined the SME Eurotab, where he became director of R & D. He put a particular attention to consolidating and improving the product development cycle in its traditional business (Detergent Tablets, EUROTAB being the pioneer for both bleach and dishwashing tablet) and creating innovation breakthroughs, opening access to new markets (for the food industry for instance). Since September 2007, he was hired as CEO for the Fondation Pierre-Gilles de Gennes, which ambitions, among other things, to bridge the gap between academic research and industry by creating partnerships based on know-how / knowledge synergy.
